1. Colour pg.no 3 to 8 in book (5 pages)

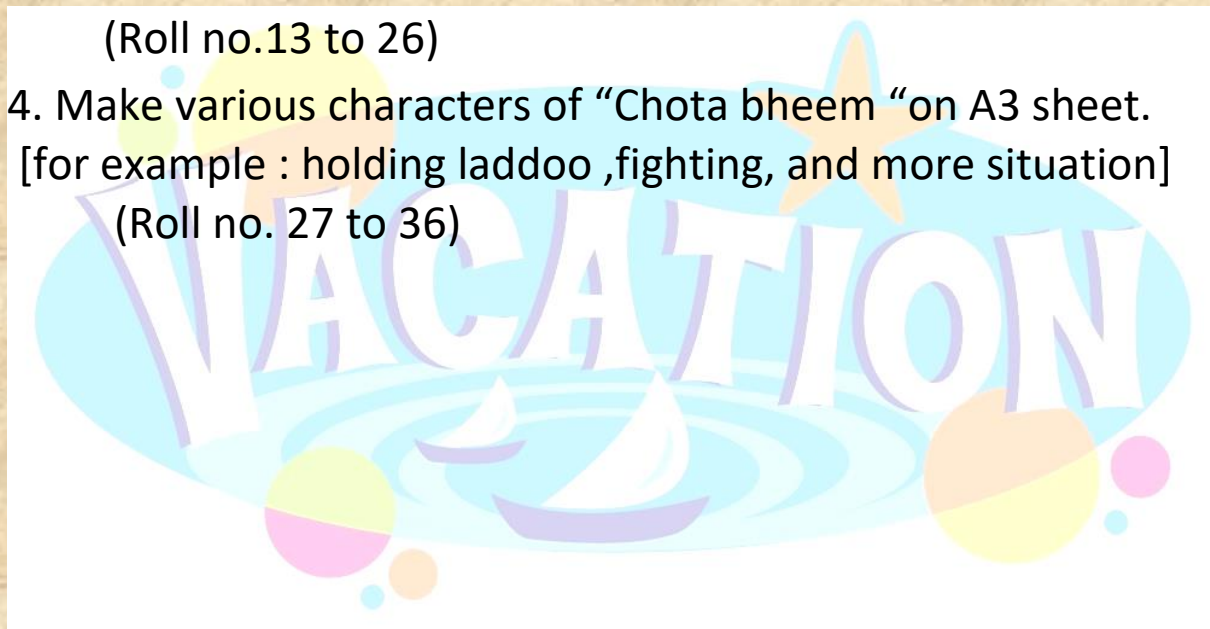
2. Make a chalk stand (Roll no.1 to 12)
